For Her in Trials

For Her Respect for Her Parents

If I say, "Surely the darkness shall cover me, and the light about me be night," even the darkness is not dark to you; the night is bright as the day, for darkness is as light with you. For you formed my inward parts; you knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. My frame was not hidden from you, when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth. Your eyes saw my unformed substance; in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me, when as yet there was none of them. How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them! If I would count them, they are more than the sand.

- I pray for healing and that You restore my daughter to full health.

For Her Armor of God

"Finally, be strong in the Lord and in the strength of his might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand firm. Stand therefore, having fastened on the belt of truth, and having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and, as shoes for your feet, having put on the readiness given by the gospel of peace. - I pray for freedom from addictions, toxic relationships, lust, and eating disorders.
- Shine the light into the darkness.
- I pray that whatever territory the enemy may have stolen from my daughter, You would restore it.

For Her Future Marriage

"But you, O Lord, are a shield about me, my glory, and the lifter of my head."

- I pray, Lord, that if it is Your will for my daughter to get married, You would give her the wisdom and discernment she needs to choose a spouse.
- I pray for him at this moment in time, and that he would come to know You in a personal way.
- I pray for my daughter as she begins to date.
- I pray Your protection over her body and her mind.
- Give her discernment to identify dangerous situations and the courage and strength to stand up for herself if she needs to.

For Her Teachable Spirit

For Her Unique Passions

- I pray that my daughter will devote herself to things that are life-giving, healthy, and honoring to God.
- I pray that she will be drawn to activities and interests that will lead her to positive friendships and that will develop her God-given gifts and talents.

For Her Time at School
